The Health & Safety Representative uses external consultancy advice to assist in the application of certain health and safety matters.


The following main applications operate throughout all sites, and with Trucks, Vans and Trailers whilst actively operating:

1. Instructions are posted regarding evacuation in the event of Fire, Explosion or other crisis.
2. Trained First Aiders and First Aid Kits are provided.
3. Accidents & Incidents must be recorded in compliance with regulation, in the Treatment Record & accident Book.
4. COSHH inspections are undertaken on a regular basis.
5. The company complies with regulations covering use of Display Screen Equipment, smoking, and Electricity at Work requirements.
6. Periodic Risk assessments are undertaken in accordance with Law.
7. The Company complies with regulations concerned with the Employers Duty of Care, makes proper facilities available to personnel, and requires employees to comply with requirements for personnel duty of commitment.

Whilst the company is not certificated to BS OHSAS 18001 or to CHAS, it does make every effort to comply with these standards.

This Policy applies to all employees, visitors to the site, and where appropriate to the general public.
